In order to acquaint the public with their beauty and to encourage their preservation, the native plants on the Wildflower Preservation List (Endangered/Threatened) should not be exhibited in a Flower Show unless it is grown by the exhibitor & so identified. Members are encouraged to promote the propagation of endangered species by utilizing them in their landscape with the long-term goal of removing them from the "list." Asuccess=Johnsons's Frankenia was removed in 2019. Threatened went from 6 plants to 15, March 30, 2020. No plants were added or removed from the list since spring 2021. 3/7/2023 BB
